


51&52. Locate the Seat Pedestal (C), swivel base (D) and seat base (E). Place the swivel base (D) on the welded bolt located on the Seat Pedestal (C), attach the Seat Base (E) and Swivel Base (D) to the seat pedestal with a metal washer

STEP 2: Locate the Mesh Seat and Plastic Tubes (J), the Seat Tubes (F) and the Back Seat Tubes (H). With the Plastic Tube's inserted into the Mesh Seat, slide the Mesh Seat and Plastic Tubes (J) into the Seat Tubes (F) and Back Seat Tubes (H). Note: It is easier to slide mesh seat and plastic tubes starting from the

straight end of the seat tubes. Bolt the Back Seat Tubes (H) to the Seat Tubes (F) using two (2) 6mm x 1-5/8" bolts and locknuts. Locate the Front Seat Support Tube (G) and the Back Seat Support (I). Bolt the Front Seat Support Tube to the front side of the Seat Tubes (F) using one (1) 8mm x 2-1/8" bolt and a thick plastic washer on each side. Next Bolt the Back Seat Support (I) to the Back Seat Tubes (H) using one (1) 6mm x 1-5/8" on each side.

STEP 6: Locate the Arm Rests (K), bolt the Arm Rests (K) to the Back Seat Tubes (H) with two (2) 6mm x 2-1/8" bolts and locknuts. Next using one (1) 6mm x 2-1/8" bolt and locknut, bolt through the bottom side of the Arm Rest (K), the Seat Base (E) and lastly through the Seat Tube (F). Repeat on the opposite side. Using two (2) 6mm x 1-3/4" bolts and locknuts, finish bolting the Seat Tubes (F) to the Seat Base (E). 01-2021A



STEP 2: Locate the two (2) foot platforms (A) and the sub-frame (B). Secure the foot platforms (A) and sub-frame (B) using eight (8) 8mm x 2-3/8" bolts and four (4) 8mm locknuts.

STEP 3: Locate four (4) rail support tubes (M). Secure each end of the rail support tubes to each corner of the assembled foot platform side using (4) 8mm x 2-1/8" bolts and locknuts. NOTE: The pre-welded tubes on the rail support tubes shall be facing inwards toward the center of the foot platform area.



STEP 4: Locate (1) platform rail strap(s) (N) and align the hole on the platform strap with the 2nd hole on the rail support tube (M) and the 2nd hole from the corner in the assembled foot platform and secure each end using (1) 8mm x 1-3/8" bolt and locknut. Repeat on remaining (3) Platform Rail Strap(s). Note: Insure the locknuts are to the inside of the foot platform area.

STEP 5: Locate the two (2) shooting rails (O) and two (2) rail link tubes (P). Slide the rail link tube (P) over the end of one (1) of the shooting rail (O), Slide the second shooting rail (O) into the rail link tube. Line the holes up and secure them to the rail support tubes (M) using two (2) 6mm x 2-1/8" bolts and 6mm locknuts. Repeat on other side.

STEP 6: Install the previously assembled seat to the platform using four (4) 8mm x 1-5/8" bolts and locknuts. Note: Once you have one of the swivel seats installed, there are two optional locations to install another swivel seat, Repeat for the second independent swivel seat location you choose.




Note: All required bolts and nuts for the leg/cross brace/ladder assembly are in poly bag # 54.

STEP 7: Locate the (4) upper cross braces (W) (1" Tube) and the (4) lower cross braces (X) (3/4" tube). Insert the (1) lower cross braces (X) into (1) upper cross braces (W) and align the holes in the end and secure using one (1) 8mm x 1-3/8" bolt and locknut per braces. Note: Bolt together using the hole that is 2" up from the end on the upper cross brace tube. Repeat this STEP on the remaining cross brace assemblies (four total). Note: The cross braces are square tubes their entire length.

STEP 8: Locate the (4) top side braces (Y) (1" Tube) and the (4) bottom side braces (Z) (3/4" tube). Insert the (1) lower side brace (Z) (3/4" tube) into the end of upper side brace (Y) (1" tube) where the hole is punched about 2" UP from the end. Secure the two sections together using (1) 8mm x 1-3/8" bolt and locknut. Repeat on remaining Cross Supports. Note: Insure to orient each end of the upper/lower cross support tubes.


bolt the four (4) leg assemblies to the (4) mounting locations on platform (A) with 8mm x 2" bolt and locknuts.

STEP 10: Locate the two (2) ladder connection tubes (L). Install them onto the welded cross tubes on one end of the foot platform (A). Secure using two (2) 8mmx2-3/8" bolts and locknuts per ladder connection tube (L). NOTE: Both foot platforms (A) are drilled for the ladder connection tubes (L). Placement of the ladder connection tubes (L) on either foot platform (A) is up to the user's discretion.


STEP 11: Locate the ladder sections (V). Slide the one (1) ladder section (V) into the ladder connection tubes (L) and connect using two (2) quick pins. Make certain the quick pins are closed and locked once their installation is completed. Repeat on the 2nd ladder section.

INSTALLING CANVAS CANOPY



STEP 1: STOP! It is **REQUIRED** to tape all corners and bolted joints on the canopy assembly so that all sharp edges and bolts are covered to prevent ripping of the canvas enclosure fabric. NOTE: The enclosure fabric or zippers are NOT warranted!! These STEPS require two (2) adults for the safe installation of canopy. Locate the canopy (R). Note there are windows on the sides of the canopy and a window and vertical zipper for easy treestand access on the front of the canopy as shown in Figure 8.

STEP 2: While standing on the foot platform, lower the previously installed canopy frame by loosening the T-Bolts and allowing the canopy frame to slide downward. Retighten the T-Bolts. With the help of another adult, push the canvas canopy through the previously assembled canopy frame. Make certain the zippered door is facing the ladder side of the quad-pod assembly.

STEP 3: Gently work the canvas canopy down and over the canopy frame and down the sides of the canopy frame. Make certain the canvas canopy is squarely installed on the canopy frame. Once the canvas canopy has been installed, gently raise the canopy frame upward until the bottom of the canvas canopy is flush, or below the foot platforms. At desired height, tighten the canopy frame T-Bolts and secure the bottom of the canopy to the foot platforms.

CANOPY WITH VERTICAL Note: You must leave the canvas canopy windows open when not in use. This keeps the wind from blowing the quad-pod assembly over during periods of high winds.

Note: It is **REQUIRED** to tape all corners and bolted joints on the canopy assembly to prevent ripping of canvas enclosure fabric. The enclosure fabric or zippers are **NOT** warranted. Please call to purchase replacement fabric enclosure. (Part # RTQF-500)

WARNING! Your Rhino Quad Pod was designed, engineered and constructed in a manner that makes it a rugged piece of hunting equipment that will give you years of trouble-free service. This rugged-construction makes your Rhino Quad Pod physically heavy. As such, you shall never attempt to install this ladder by yourself.

WARNING! Prior to attempting to climb a ladder stand for the first time, make certain the feet of the bottom rung ladder section are firmly planted on solid, level ground. If they are not firmly planted on level ground, DO NOT climb the ladder. With the help of three (3) adults, lower the stand and find a suitable location to safely install the ladder stand. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! When climbing, always maintain three (3) points-of-contact as you ascend (i.e., climb up) and while descending (i.e., climb down). Failure to maintain three (3) points-of-contact puts the user at serious risk of bodily injury. Failure to follow these instructions will result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! Prior to climbing, make sure that all the ladder sections are firmly connected and the ladder assembly is solidly secured to the tree. Failure to follow these instructions will result in serious injury or death!

Any installation other than level, will result in dangerous condition for the user. if you find your treestand canted, unlevel or in any condition other than level, you must remove it and find an alternative installation site that affords level installation. Failure to follow these instructions will result in serious injury or death!

STEP 1: (This STEP requires (4) adults). With the quad-pod FULLY assembled on it's side (Note: Have the platform assembly on a chair or table so it's off the ground to prevent stress in the canopy assembly), tie off (2) 16' ropes or straps (not included) near the foot plates on the each leg assembly that are not touching the ground (the two in the air). Locate (1) able adult on each side of the foot platform area (near leg connection to the foot platform). With (1) able adult pulling on each of the ropes attached to each leg assembly and (1) able adult pushing on each rear corner of foot platform/rear leg assembly, pull the unit up until all foot plates are on the ground and the foot platform is level. DO NOT allow the unit to slam against the ground during set-up or removal. IT IS REQUIRED TO STAKE THIS UNIT INTO THE GROUND (not included).

STEP 2: With the treestand erected, make certain the seating platform is level and the treestand is installed on solid, level ground. If the seat or standing platforms are not level, or the treestand is not on level, firm ground, gently lower it (with the help of three (3) adults [four (4) total) and move it to a location where it can be erected in the safe manner previously described in this Manual.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: You must tie-down or secure your Rhino Treestands Quad-Pod using stakes or straps. Please note that stakes or straps are NOT PROVIDED with this Rhino Treestands Quad-Pod. It is recommended that you tie-down each side of the platforms [4] total). It is recommended that you leave the windows open when not in use to minimize the effects of the wind on the structure. Additionally, it is highly recommended that a certified electrician ground this structure in the event of an electrical storm.

REMOVING YOUR RTT-510 TREESTAND



WARNING! NEVER walk or stand under the treestand at any time during set-up or removal. Failure to follow these instructions may resulting serious injury or death!

STEP 1: It is required to have (4) able adults to raise or lower this unit into position. Read/Understand/Follow all instructions/ warning prior to set-up/removal/or use of this unit!! Remove all ground stakes or anchors that are securing the unit to the ground. Next, tie off (2) 16' rope or strap (not included) to the front two legs in the direction you want to lay the unit to the ground. With (1) able adult on each rear leg section and (1) able adult on each 16' strap or rope, push the unit over and control the fall rate of the unit to the ground be slowly walking the unit down with the (1) rope or strap, DO NOT ALLOW THE UNIT TO SLAM AGAINST THE GROUND. Never stand in the direct path of the unit being raised or lowered to the ground.



WARNING! Prior to attempting to use this or any other Rhino Treestands product(s), you must take a moment and become familiar with it's setup and installation at ground level. You must practice installing, setting-up and using this product(s) at ground-level prior to attempting to use it at heights above ground-level. Once you have become thoroughly knowledgeable and comfortable with this Rhino Treestands product(s) setup, installation and use at ground-level, you're now ready to use it at heights above ground-level. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!

STORAGE AND CARE

WARNING! You MUST store your treestand out of direct sunlight and out of any other harsh environmental condition(s) that may adversely affect its performance. Storing this treestand in harsh environmental conditions will degrade its performance and may expose the user to serious injury or death. Failure to follow these instruction will lead to serious injury or death!

You must remove the fabric enclosure when not in use. Direct sunlight will fade the enclosure material and environmental conditions will wear on the fabric material. The fabric enclosure/zippers are NOT warranted. Call Rhino Treestands or your local retailer for purchase of replacement enclosure fabric.
